I have spent 44 years in nursing and healthcare within Canada and the United States, focusing on direct-care practice (including northern outpost nursing) of the acutely ill individual (primary clinical experience is acute-care: critical care, cardiothoracic nursing and multi-organ transplantation). Up to 2017, I continued to work actively at the bedside (ACLS certified) alongside my nursing staff, maintaining a high-level of passion for acute care clinical practice. Since returning to academia in 2017, I have spent my time balancing classroom teaching (Undergraduate Leadership and Graduate Studies in the Canadian Healthcare System and Advanced Practice Nursing) with research, knowledge translation and dissemination and clinical teaching in acute med-surg. My approach to nursing practice respects the importance of leadership, education and research in the quality preparation, transition, integration, stabilization and ongoing development of nurses within the professional workforce. My early career was spent working in direct care as a practicing nurse and nursing/critical care educator, with numerous opportunities to teach and practice in Canada and the United States. Mid-career offered me opportunities to develop and manage high volume cardiothoracic transplant programs and I served as the Lead Clinician/Program Coordinator for 3 multidisciplinary transplant teams, including a heart-lung transplant program in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada, a multi-organ donor program at the Toronto General Hospital in Toronto, Ontario, Canada, and a single and double lung transplant program at Barnes Hospital at Washington University in St. Louis, Missouri, USA. I completed my US work coordinating the US operations for a cardio-sciences specialty company (SCIMED) in Minneapolis, Minnesota, USA. I have spent my career creating, developing, educating and managing multidisciplinary teams for the purpose of optimizing quality healthcare and clinical practice programs.

Over the past 25 years of my career, I have focused on advancing the knowledge of professional role transition of new nurses into contemporary professional practice; I developed a theory of the stages of role transition and transition shock and have written a book on that theory that are being used globally (Canada, the US, Australia, New Zealand and Asia) as the framework for nursing residency and new nurse integration programs. With a strong ideological basis in the translation of what we 'know' as nurses into what we 'do' and 'how' we do it, I have committed much of my time and energy to addressing the issues related to the practice of quality nursing.

In 2004, I created and launched a non-profit organization (Nursing The Future™) that continues to guide the experiences of newly graduated nurses and those who support their practice. Currently working with funding from the Canadian Nurses Foundation, NTF serves as the only non-work graduate nurse support network in North America. This online platform offers nurses of all scopes and stages who are educating, practicing, managing, developing policy, serving as administrators and leaders of nursing and healthcare, and directing our professional associations insight into, and strategies to address issues related to the preparation, orientation, transition, integration and stabilization of the newest members of our workforce.

From August 2014 – June 2017 I managed a 41-bed acute-care cardiology/telemetry unit (STEMI/NSTEMI, heart failure, vascular surgery, interventional cardiology) in a large urban Saskatchewan hospital. In July 2017 I rejoined the academic ranks as an Associate Professor at the School of Nursing at Thompson Rivers University where I have taught at both undergraduate and graduate levels. In 2023 I retired from my academic role to devote the remainder of my career to supporting newly graduated nurses. I am pleased to continue the development and delivery of grassroots support, education and connecting networks for new nurses as Director of Nursing The Future™ (funded through the *Canadian Nurses Foundation*). Further, I am grateful to work with an outstanding research team (Dr. Angela Wolff, Dr. Martin Charette and Research Coordinator Kathryn Corneau) in developing, implementing and evaluating a *National New Nurse Graduate Residency Program* in collaboration with the *Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing* and funded by Health Canada (2023-2027).
